活動目標

- 認識中國文房四寶
- 認識中國武術
- 認識中國傳統樂器

活動簡介

在十週年校慶暨中華文化畢業典禮匯演中, K2 及 K3 幼兒分別表演了舞蹈《文房四寶》、《霍 元甲》以及中國節奏樂。在《文房四寶》的舞蹈中,幼兒透過書本和毛筆道具,了解筆、墨、 紙、硯是中國書法和繪畫藝術的基本工具,並配合歌曲《孔子曰》,理解論語中的教誨:「非 禮勿視,非禮勿聽,非禮勿言,非禮勿動。」在《霍元甲》的舞蹈中,加入了功夫元素,讓幼 兒明白一個人要有文有武,智勇雙全,並理解功夫是中國傳統的國術。最後,在節奏樂中,幼 兒使用中式樂器參與表演,並配合歌曲《龍的傳人》,讓他們更深入了解中國傳統藝術文化。
